Fr. Salisbury Steak Bites

This fourth Sunday of Easter is always celebrated as Good Shepherd Sunday. One of the most beloved images of Our Lord from the Scriptures. From the images of Psalm 23 of Our Lord leading us to verdant green pastures of rest, and along calm peaceful rivers; to the images from the gospels of Jesus going in search of the one lost sheep, finding it, and placing it with joy on His shoulders to carry it home. These are beautiful images. In order for us as the sheep to truly live them, one thing we absolutely need in our Lord is trust.

Growing in trust in any relationship is always a journey, and with any journey we know there can be road blocks that slow or even stop the journey. In our relationship with our Lord there are 3 blocks that can make it difficult for us to trust Him. The three blocks are, unforgiveness, sin/unrepentance, unholy self-control. Unforgiveness hardens are heart and closes it off to being vulnerable, and vulnerability is needed for trust. Sin/Unrepentance cuts God's life out of souls and lets our pride dictate our actions and not trust in God's goodness. Unholy self-control leaves our hearts and hands closed, unable to receive what Jesus wants to give us. If we notice that any of these three are part of our lives right now, going to Our Lord concretely prayer in areas of Forgiveness, Repentance, and Surrender help destroy those blocks and open the doors of our hearts to Jesus. I've included simple prayers that you can included in your prayer life, especially if you notice a struggle in any of these areas.

Forgiveness Prayer: "In the name of Jesus, I forgive (say their name) for (doing X or Y). <you can repeat this prayer 2 or 3 times>

Repentance Prayer: "Jesus I am sorry for (state particular sin). Thank you for your mercy and forgiveness."

Surrender of Control Prayer: "Jesus, I come before you just as I am and I surrender my life to you, all that a I am and all that I have. I am sorry for the ways I have tried to control my life and rely on myself. I'm sorry for not being open to your love and guidance. From this day forward, I choose to follow you and I invite you to guide my life."
