CHANGE IN AREAS: Please note that Area 1 no longer includes the basement. Area 4 now includes the basement and the choir loft, and will be on the schedule for cleaning twice a month during the CCD school year.

#### IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

1. For convenience the large vacuum cleaner and the yellow vacuum cleaners and their long hose are in the SOUTH utility closet in the hallway between the gathering area and the banquet hall. Also the Church Cleaning Notebook is on the wall and the hall bathrooms' cleaning supplies are on the shelves in the SOUTH utility closet. Check the book to see what someone else has already cleaned in your assigned Area, then when you're done cleaning, date and mark down what you cleaned.

The steam mop, pads, orange extension cord, and vacuum cleaner bags

are now in the utility closet as well. A cup to fill the reservoir of the steam mop with water is under the women's bathroom sink. You will need the orange extension cord to reach the bathrooms with the steam mop if you plug into the hallway outlet.

2. It is very important that dust spray is NOT used on the organ. It has been suggested that all dusting be done with a dry cloth. Also, anything that is gold plated, such as things on the altar, should not be touched with bare hands, as the oils on our skin

will ruin the finish over time, and it is very costly to have things re-plated. Dust these items with a dry cloth.
